Measurable progress in a reasonable amount of time

Journey of 1,000 miles

Most people **overestimate** what they can accomplish in a year, and **underestimate** what they can accomplish in 10 years

It's best to set a BIG goal, pick a date for it, and then work back from there

Once you have the goal and deadline, break it down into phases or big milestones

Let's say you wanted to have a fully functioning
online course

One year may be ambitious if you've never done it before, but I'd say it's possible if you had the right skills

Some big milestones would be creating all the base documents and resources

Another big milestones might be completing all the presentation slides

And yet another big milestone would be completing the recordings

The last milestone may be uploading them to your website and uploading all the documents and presentation slides

This last step could take a lot longer if you don't know the first thing about coding or websites

The first schedules you create may not be accurate, but it's important to try to account for your time as it relates to progress

The goal should be bigger than you and the attainment of it should be something that excites you into action

Journey of 1,000 miles

It's been said we need reminding as much as
we need the initial education

And I've found this to be very true

And I'm a fan of how this Ancient Chinese
proverb makes me feel too

It's inspiring and motivating, and it also makes
logical and mathematical sense

The journey of 1,000 miles begins with a single step

Attributed to Chinese Philosopher Lao Tzu,
found in Tao Te Ching, a classic text written
around 6th century BC

The one step seems insignificant at first,

And if you measure the distance travelled as a percentage of total distance, it is very insignificant

But you shouldn't discount the step, because it is measurable, and you can track the time it took you to make the step

And once you have the step per unit time, you can extrapolate out time needed to advance to your destination

I.e. One step was two feet, and it took you 3 seconds

5,280 ft in a mile, therefore one mile is 2,640 steps,
which would take 132 minutes or 2.2 hrs

1,000 miles would then take you 2,200 hours, or 91
days, assuming you went 24/7

The first step is the most important

And it takes faith, power, ability and will to do it

And as soon as you make the first step, the rest of the journey is measurably shorter

And every step gets you closer to your
destination
